## The Process:

**Selection:** The Festival of Lights committee will review all nominations. This committee is comprised of York community members who then choose 5 finalists. These nominations are submitted to the York Region Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors who then make the final decision.

**Criteria:** Volunteer efforts must benefit the town of York. Nominee does not have to be a resident of York. Chamber Board of Directors are not eligible.

**Deadline** for nominations is **October 1, 2016**. Winner will be announced at the Annual Chamber Member Dinner scheduled for November. The winner will also be recognized in the official Citizen of the Year press release. The winner will also be the Grand Marshal for the Festival of Lights Parade.
